OUR ACCOMPLISHMENTS -YEAR ONE

- Established partnerships with Indiana University, Indiana Department of Education, Institute for Educational Leadership, and 15 leadership organizations and agencies.
- Established Regional Stakeholder Groups at each site including community, staff, and family members representing the populations of the region.
- Hosted our first statewide virtual conference: THE FAMILY EFFECT.
- Established webpages on our central site and at each model site with video stories.
- Provided 74 activities to develop state-level leadership.
- Recorded 4942 parents who participated in engagement activities year one.
- Conducted the first annual survey of families and staff members to inform initiatives.
